


# Marta Chilindrón's ***Mobius Houston***

## FUN FACTS

- *Mobius Houston* is Marta Chilindrón's first large-scale public art project in Texas.
- It is 11 feet tall and 22 feet wide, weighing over two tons.
- The trapezoidal acrylic panels that create the artwork use force and expert geometry to hold the shape upright.
- *Mobius Houston* builds on South American traditions of using geometric abstraction and concrete art to explore ideas on the infinite, perception, and transformation.
- A major player in these ideals is Chilindrón's use of color. When the colorful panels overlap the perception of a new color is created.
